As we go through life it's interesting the things that stay in our minds compared with the things that don't. One of the strange things that has stayed with me from several years ago is seeing a really simple but profound illustration from the American church leader Rob Bell.

Rob was in the middle of a talk when he began speaking about the dimensions that we see in. To illustrate the point, he held up a board marker in front of his audience. He pointed to the different surfaces of the pen that his viewers could see and then talked about the ones that we couldn't see, but we knew were there. He went on to say that we knew about three and four dimensions, yet scientists had proven that there were at least 7 dimensions that they knew of and there may be many more besides. He went on to say that imagine God seeing in all of these dimensions all at the same time, seeing everything that is going on from every possible angle and seeing the beginning and the end of something all at once.

This illustration has helped my faith, especially in times when I don't understand what is going on. I don't need to know the end from the beginning, because I can trust the one who does and he is the one who will work

everything out for all our goods when the time is right.

He is the Alpha and the Omega the beginning and the end.
